OVER 1,100 VULNERABLE HOUSEHOLDS TO RECEIVE HOUSEHOLD PACKS UNDER ADOPT @ SOUTH WEST PROGRAMME

- More than 400 ExxonMobil staff volunteers and their families to be involved in the distribution
- Household packs specially curated to provide households with daily necessities
