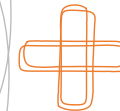

Interim Relief
Up to \$1,000 per household* and household installations and furnishing, where applicable

* Households facing crisis, such as house on fire, loss of sole breadwinner's income, bed bugs infestation, etc.



Transport and Mobility

Assistive Support
Up to \$500 for assistive technology devices

Transport Subsidy

- Up to \$100 subsidy for training and employment
- \$120 bursary for primary to secondary students
- Up to \$600 subsidy for medical transport
- Up to \$300 taxi vouchers



Healthcare

Financial Support for Caregivers
One-time \$500 for self-care and/or caregiving expenses

Baby Essentials
Diapers for low-income families with babies below 36 months old

Dental Care
Up to \$750 dental subsidy

Meals Delivery
Daily meals delivery for the disabled vulnerable

 - Total Gross Monthly Household Income of \$3,500 or Per Capita Income (PCI) of \$875, whichever is lower; and
 - Discretion of the Grassroots Leaders / Volunteers for residents with exceptional family and financial difficulties.
